What is ABA?

ABA (Applied Behavior Analysis) is the science of behavior. ABA programs are led by BCBAs (Board Certified Behavior Analyst) who have graduate level training in behavioral principles. Therapists trained in ABA use positive reinforcement to build motivation in individuals to learn new skills (language, daily living, academics, social skills) as well as decrease unwanted behaviors (crying, tantrums, etc). It is also widely known as the most evidenced based treatment for individuals with Autism.
